Guidelines for Rental of the Aloha Stadium VIP Sky Box Suite, Club Box and VIP Field Suites

VIP Package:

1. VIP Sky Box Suite includes:
 - a. Hawaii Booth – 24 Guest Admission Passes / Kauai Booth – 20 Guest Admission Passes
 - b. Hawaii Booth – 12 Parking Passes / Kauai Booth – 10 Parking Passes
 - c. Food and beverage catered by Centerplate
 - d. Hosted alcoholic beverages.

2. VIP Field Level Suite (Makai) includes:
 - a. 24 Guest Admission Passes
 - b. 12 Parking Passes
 - c. Food and beverage catered by Centerplate
 - d. No-Host Alcoholic beverages

3. VIP Club includes:
 - a. 24 Guest Admission Passes
 - b. 12 Parking Passes
 - c. Food and beverage catered by Centerplate
 - d. Hosted alcoholic beverages.

Payment:

- Cash, Cashiers/Bank Draft, Money Order, Traveler's Check, payable to "Stadium Authority". Cash payment shall be accepted in person by Fiscal Office personnel and a receipt issued to validate cash payment.
- Deposit shall be non-refundable.
- Admission tickets and parking passes will be issued to Client upon receipt of rental payment-in-full.

Game Day Experience:

- Guests will be allowed in the stadium when turnstiles open to the public – generally 1/ ½ hours prior to kick-off.

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- For the Skybox/Club box, all guests must enter through the security gate and provide admission tickets at the time of entry. Skybox guests will use the south elevator to the 3rd floor skybox. Club Box guests will use the south elevator to the 4th floor – section E.
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- Field suite guests will enter through the turnstile gates and have access to the field suite via C or CC stairs.
- Guests must wear ticket lanyards when entering and exiting the skybox or field suite.
- Any additional requests must be made at least one week prior to game day. We will try to accommodate your request to the best of our abilities.
- Skybox and Club Box guests may be escorted to the field for 10-15 minutes with a stadium usher during the 1st quarter of the game.

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Aloha Stadium Tailgate Policy

The TAILGATE POLICY is in place for the safety and enjoyment of ALL guests attending an event at the Aloha Stadium. Please enjoy yourself!

The Following is PROHIBITED in all parking areas:

- 1. RESERVED STALLS.** As part of your VIP Package, you are provided with a designated number of parking stalls. If you are planning on tailgating prior to entering the stadium, and plan to utilize more than one stall, please arrange for vehicles to enter the parking lot at the same time to allow for adjacent stalls. You will not be allowed to “save” stalls.
- 2. UTILIZING MORE THAN ONE STALL.** Vehicles, tables, chairs, barbecue pits and tents must be confined to only one stall. You must have a vehicle in the stall during all times while tailgating.
- 3. DUMPING.** Please make sure hot coals are not dumped in the parking lot or trash receptacles.
- 4. RECREATIONAL PLAY.** Please do not toss footballs, frisbees or any other type of ball in the parking lot. No bikes, scooters, rollerblades or skateboards are allowed in the parking lot.
- 5. ANIMALS.** Only service pets will be allowed on property.
- 6. NO LIVE BANDS/LOUD MUSIC.**
- 7. LITERATURE.** Soliciting, hawking, selling and giveaways of any kind are prohibited without prior approval from Aloha Stadium Management.
- 8. HIGH CAPACITY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTAINERS** (ie. kegs, party balls, etc.) – these items will be confiscated and disposed. Must be 21 years or older to possess and consume alcohol.
- 9. NO PEGGING / STAKING ON FACILITY GROUNDS.**

WARNING: This is a notice of warning for all customers at Aloha Stadium. Law enforcement will actively enforce the Aloha Stadium Guest Code of Conduct, prohibited items, parking, and tailgating policies; which includes, reserving parking stalls/spaces, straddling/occupying space of adjoining stall, and failing to park within a designated parking stall. Under the HRS 109-7 (c) the violations are subject to fines of up to \$150.00.

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The following items are PROHIBITED from entering the Aloha Stadium turnstiles:

Weapons
Noise Makers
Illegal Drugs
Cans and Bottles
Umbrellas
Coolers
Fireworks
Balloons
Sticks
Outside food & Beverages
Confetti
Lasers
Inflatable objects
Poles
Skateboards
Rollerblades
Bicycles
Animals (except service animals)
Any item which may pose a health or safety issue

Smoking is prohibited except within a posted designated smoking area. (this includes vapor and electronic cigarettes)

All bags, jackets, guests and vehicles are subject to check upon entering the premises. Express lanes are available at each turnstile gate for persons without bags.

IMPORTANT NOTE: VIOLATORS ARE SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF STATE LAW AND EJECTION FROM THE ALOHA STADIUM PROPERTY. FANS MAY CALL THE ALOHA STADIUM ANONYMOUS TIP LINE TO REPORT VIOLATIONS AT 808.483.2807.

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
