## 1. Security

## HPD Special Duty

- Stadium security continues to meet with HPD Administrators to address Special Duty sign in shortage for stadium events. Several options have been implemented over the years with minimal results. A meeting is scheduled for Thursday, 6/20/19, to discuss the other options for the 2019 football season. Also, the meeting will provide an opportunity to meet the new Pearl City District Major and to discuss any other operational issues.

## 2. Chris Kinimaka – Promotion to new DAGS PWA

- Ms. Kinimaka is a Professional Mechanical Engineer with over 34 years of engineering experience and has been with the State of Hawaii for the past 27 years.
- DAGS has been fortunate to have Chris for the last 19 years working in the Public Works Division.
- As the Public Works Administrator, she will manage day-to-day operations for the division as well as serve as co-chair for the

State of Civil Defense, Emergency Support Function 3 Team, and DAGS Hi-EMA representative.

3. Louise Sper – Louise started October 16, 2016 and jumped right in during the peak of football season.

For the last 2 years she has met her goals and exceeded revenue expectations for the stadium. In addition:

- Increased sponsorship opportunities and revenue
- Created many “fan experiences” that would not be possible without her partnership and sponsorship dollars
- Increased North Plaza activity with family themed concepts
- Created an official “vendor village” so fans and sponsors would have more opportunities to interact
- Created a sponsored Fan Survey Campaign during the football season

We would also like to acknowledge Bill Cartwright (Outfront Media Sports President) and Garret Dorn for 10 years of faithful and loyal service to the State of Hawaii. We cannot thank them enough for their undying commitment to Aloha Stadium.

We have been meeting with current client to thank them for their support and to reassure them a smooth transition with our new advertising partner - IMG. (NSP-01-2018-SA). Outfront Media (IFB-08-002-SA) will end June 30<sup>th</sup> and IMG will begin July 1<sup>st</sup>.

MONTHLY SECURITY REPORT TO THE BOARD

The following is a brief summary of security related incidents which occurred from May 1, 2019, through May 31, 2019.

Monster Truck, May 4, 2019

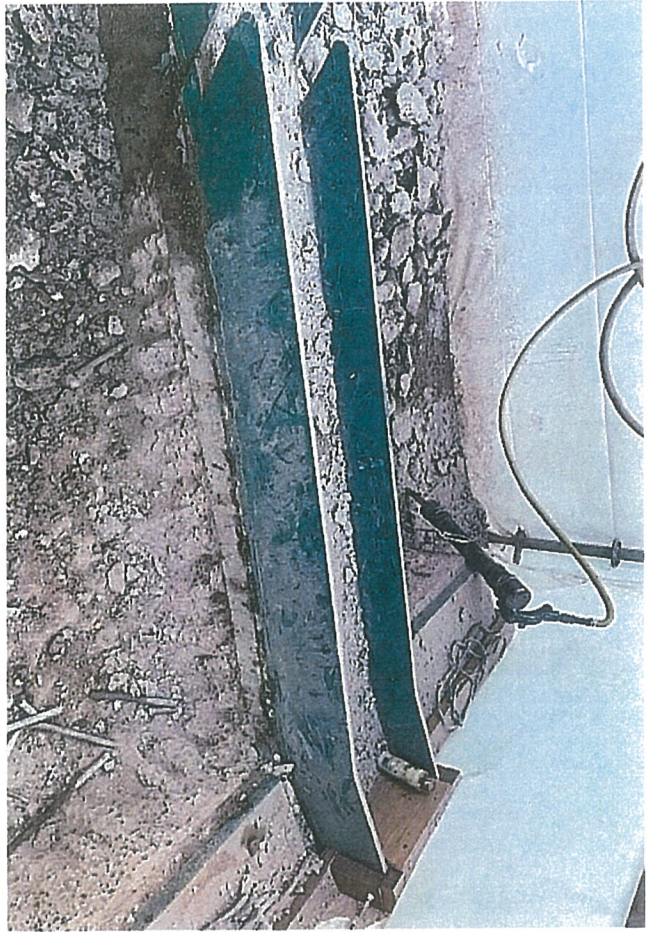


1. **H&S 5 Work**

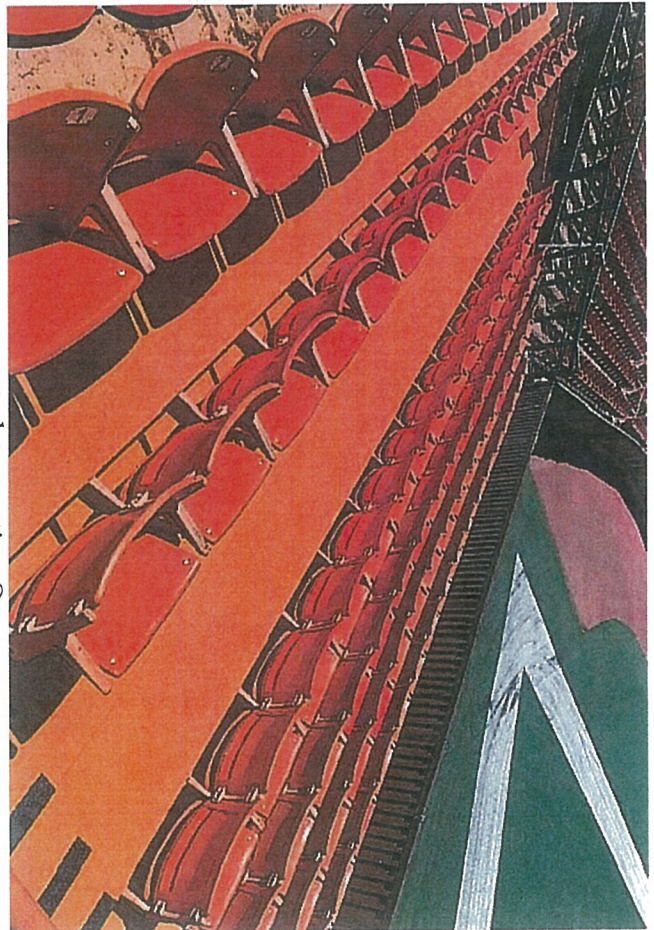
