Guidelines for Rental of the Aloha Stadium VIP Sky Box Suite, Club Box and VIP Field Suites

VIP Package:

1. VIP Sky Box Suite includes:
 - a. Hawaii Booth – 24 Guest Admission Passes / Kauai Booth – 20 Guest Admission Passes
 - b. Hawaii Booth – 12 Parking Passes / Kauai Booth – 10 Parking Passes
 - c. Food and beverage catered by Centerplate
 - d. Hosted alcoholic beverages
2. VIP Field Level Suite (Makai) includes:
 - a. 24 Guest Admission Passes
 - b. 12 Parking Passes
 - c. Food and beverage 2-hour catering by Centerplate
 - d. No-Host Alcoholic beverages
3. VIP Club includes:
 - a. 24 Guest Admission Passes
 - b. 12 Parking Passes
 - c. Food and beverage catered by Centerplate
 - d. Hosted alcoholic beverages.

Payment:

- Cash, Cashiers/Bank Draft, Money Order, Traveler's Check, payable to "Stadium Authority". Cash payment shall be accepted in person by Fiscal Office personnel and a receipt issued to validate cash payment.
- Deposit shall be non-refundable.
- Admission tickets and parking passes will be issued to Client upon receipt of rental payment-in-full.

Game Day Experience:

- Guests will be allowed in the stadium when turnstiles open to the public – generally 1/ ½ hours prior to kick-off.
- For the Skybox/Club box, all guests must enter through the security gate and provide admission tickets at the time of entry. Skybox guests will use the south elevator to the 3rd floor skybox. Club Box guests will use the south elevator to the 4th floor – section E.

- Field suite guests will enter through the turnstile gates and have access to the field suite via C or CC stairs.
- Guests must wear ticket lanyards when entering and exiting the skybox or field suite.
- Any additional requests must be made at least one week prior to game day. We will try to accommodate your request to the best of our abilities.
- Skybox and Club Box guests may be escorted to the field for 10-15 minutes with a stadium usher during the 1st quarter of the game.

Tailgating Policy

The Following is **PROHIBITED** in all parking areas:

1. **RESERVING STALLS.** Parking is on a first-come, first serve basis. Please arrange for vehicles who would like adjacent stalls for tailgating to enter the parking lot at the same time.
2. **UTILIZING MORE THAN ONE STALL.** Vehicles, tables, chairs, BBQ pits and tents must be confined to **only one stall. No pegging.**
3. **DUMPING.** Please make sure hot coals are not dumped in the parking lot or trash receptacles.
4. **RECREATIONAL PLAY.** No tossing of footballs, frisbees or any other type of objects. No bikes, scooters, rollerblades, and skateboards. No remote-control devices allowed on property.
5. **ANIMALS.** No animals are allowed at the Aloha Stadium, except for ADA-Compliant Service Animals.
6. **LIVE BANDS/LOUD MUSIC.**
7. **NO LOITERING.**
8. **NO TAILGATING** after the start of event and curfew is one hour after game.
9. **ADVERTISING.** Soliciting, hawking, literature, selling and giveaways of any kind are prohibited without prior approval from the Aloha Stadium Management.
10. **HIGH CAPACITY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTAINERS (ie. kegs, party balls, etc.)** -these items will be confiscated and may be disposed. Must be 21 years or older to possess and consume alcohol. **It is unlawful for any adult to provide or purchase alcohol for consumption by minors under the age of 21.*
11. **MOTORIZED REMOTE-CONTROLLED DEVICES.**

BAG POLICY

In an effort to enhance public safety and facilitate a faster entry through the gates, Aloha Stadium has modified its security policy by limiting the number and size of bags allowed in the stadium.

BAG RESTRICTIONS

Each person shall be allowed **one bag that does not exceed 12" x 6" x 12" in size.**

In addition, each person will be allowed to hand-carry a blanket, poncho or jacket, along with a soft-sided seat cushion.

Non-approved bags must be returned to vehicle or discarded.

The following items are PROHIBITED from entering the Aloha Stadium turnstiles:

Prohibited items include, but are not limited to:

- Any bag larger than 12" x 6" x 12"
- Weapons
- Noise Makers
- Illegal Drugs
- Cans and Bottles
- Umbrellas
- Coolers
- Fireworks
- Balloons
- Outside Food & Beverages (Snack Leis permissible unless otherwise noted, but must be pre-made with each item measuring no larger than 4" x 4" x 2", and no liquids)
- Confetti
- Lasers
- Inflatable objects
- Poles & Sticks
- Skateboards
- Rollerblades
- Bicycles
- No Animals allowed at Aloha Stadium, except for ADA-Compliant Service Animals
- Motorized remote controlled devices (including drones)
- Any items which may pose a health or safety issue to our guests and employees

Non-approved bags must be returned to vehicle or discarded. An exception will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection. Please limit the number of items you bring to the stadium on event days.

Smoking is prohibited except within a posted designated smoking area. (this includes vapor and electronic cigarettes)

All bags, jackets, guests and vehicles are subject to search upon entering the premises. Express lanes are available at each turnstile gate for persons without bags.

IMPORTANT NOTE: VIOLATORS ARE SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF STATE LAW AND EJECTION FROM THE ALOHA STADIUM PROPERTY.
