## MONTHLY SECURITY REPORT TO THE BOARD

The following is a brief summary of security related incidents which occurred from October 1, 2019, through October 31, 2019.

### Criminal Property Damage

On October 19, 2019, during the UH football game, a vehicle was damaged in the Upper Halawa Parking Lot. Honolulu Police Department (HPD) was called and an HPD Report was filed. The incident was captured by Aloha Stadium surveillance cameras and a copy of the video was provided to HPD, along with a possible name of the suspect.

### Motor Vehicle Collision/Fled Scene

On October 20, 2019, during Swap Meet, a vehicle owner reported someone had damaged their vehicle, which was parked in the Upper Halawa Parking Lot. There was no note and no witnesses in the area. HPD was called and an HPD Report was filed.

### UH Football versus Air Force Academy on October 19, 2019

Stadium Nurses reported 6 Medical Assistance Calls. Three calls were for Injured Cared For (ICF). In one case, the injured person suffered injuries to their hand in the Parking Lot. The injured person was evaluated and treated by Stadium Nurse, then released to the Sheriff Dept, related to a possible criminal case. In the second case, the injured person (Stadium Employee) was evaluated and treated by Stadium Nurse, then released to their Supervisor. The injured person was cleared by the Stadium Nurse to drive themselves to the Emergency Room. In the third case, the injured person was evaluated and treated by Stadium Nurse, then released to their friends to go watch the game.

Three calls were for Sick Cared For (SCF). In one case, the person feeling sick was evaluated and treated by the Stadium Nurse and Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs), then transported to the Emergency Room via ambulance. In the second case, the person feeling sick was evaluated and treated by Stadium Nurse and EMTs, then released to their friend, who agreed to transport the person feeling sick to the Emergency Room. In the third case, the person feeling sick was evaluated and treated by the Stadium Nurse, then released to their family member, who agreed to drive the person feeling sick home.

### OIA Football on October 26, 2019

Stadium Nurses reported 2 Medical Assistance Calls. Both calls were for Injured Cared For (ICF). In one case, the injured person and their life partner refused treatment from the Stadium Nurse and left the Stadium property. In the second case, the injured person was evaluated and treated by Stadium Nurse, then released to a family member, who agreed to transport the injured person to the Emergency Room.

### Swap Meets in September 2019

Stadium Nurses reported 4 Medical Assistance Calls. All 4 calls were Injured Cared For (ICF). In one case, the injured person was evaluated and treated by Stadium Nurse, then released on their own. In the second case, the injured person was evaluated and treated by the Stadium Nurse, then released on their own to catch an Uber. In the third case, the injured person was evaluated and treated by the Stadium Nurse, then released on their own, with the advice from the Stadium Nurse to follow up at Urgent Care if the injury does not improve or gets worse. In the fourth case, the injured person was evaluated and treated by Stadium 

Nurse, then released to a family member, who agreed to transport the injured person to Urgent Care.

1. **H&S 5 Work**

General Updates

In 2018 there was 2 UH Football games with a modified set up. The modified Swap Meet has a decreased attendance thus reducing the daily averages.


In 2019 there was only 1 UH Football game and it was an early game, completely closing the Swap Meet. As a result, it is one less day open causing the average to be normal.

## Kamehameha Highway

## SEGMENT 1 - OVERALL INSTALLATION PROGRESS






