MONTHLY SECURITY REPORT TO THE BOARD

The following is a brief summary of security related incidents which occurred from November 1, 2020, through November 30, 2020.

Theft in the Second Degree

Honolulu Police Department (HPD) was called and an HPD Report was filed for Terroristic Threatening in the First Degree. HPD arrested the Vendor and transported him Off Stadium Property

Engineering Branch Report For Stadium Authority Board Meeting December 7, 2020

1. UH Football

- a. On-going work to prepare facility to host football events and clean-up afterward.
 - i. Groom and paint field.
 - ii. Clean locker rooms, restrooms and all working spaces.
 - iii. Inspections of electrical, plumbing and safety on-going.

2. Maintenance & Facility Items

- a. Priority project is rust mitigation along seat plates to cover holes and "soft spots" using metal plating. This work includes using a Needle Gun to remove the rust layer, applying a rust prevention coating, welding sheet metal over the hole or "soft spot" and then painting.
- b. Reattaching drain covers and rusted/corroded drains in seating areas.
- c. Spot repairing rusted/corroded railing connections in seating areas.
- d. The focus of this work is in lower bowl areas (orange and blue sections).
- 3. Tree work Will begin in late December around circle lot and within stadium proper.
- 4. Parking Lot cold-patching of potholes on-going.
- 5. Concourse deck patching on-going.
- 6. WJE Structural Assessment
 - a. On-site assessment complete. Awaiting draft report.
 - b. Report will establish the priority for health and safety repairs.
 - c. Following the review and acceptance of the report, the next step will be to commence design work for prioritized projects.

General Updates

- Due to the ongoing Covid situation and overarching impact, new and renewal business negotiations have been affected greatly. Our team is still engaged with all clients to ensure ongoing relationships with a focus on future years and growth once more events and fan attendance resumes
- Within the roster of signed/multi-year sponsors (listed below), our focus is on de-risking as much of the contractual investment as possible, to lessen post-season refund and credit discussions. These de-risking initiatives mostly fall within the below categories:
 - Alternate branding and exposure: e.g. shifting dollars dedicated to outer-concourse signage to new inner-bowl, lower level TV-visible signage (Hawaiian Financial FCU)
 - o New events: e.g. Halloween Trunk or Treat (Hawaiian Financial FCU)
 - Existing events: e.g. Swap Meet (currently in market/negotiation)
 - o Digital/social media concepts: e.g. social media campaigns and promotions
- Along with current sponsor management and de-risking initiatives, we are also focused on long-term initiatives to establish new revenue generating opportunities within our existing and new sponsor base. One initiative specifically is regarding Learfield IMG College's FanBase/Fan365 programs, where we work with managed properties to build out fan databases for sponsor engagement and other initiatives applicable for the property/Aloha Stadium. This is already in development, and we are working closely with Aloha Stadium staff on this endeavor.

Purpose: Update the Stadium Authority on various activities concerning NASED.

1. Governance

• A new bill has been drafted in collaboration with key stakeholders to be considered in the 2021 legislative session. The new bill will seek the establishment of developmental powers to the Stadium Authority.

2. Financial

- •Meetings between the Financial Advisor and the Stadium Authority, DAGS, and Office of Budget & Finance continue to occur related to procurement strategies and financial close requirements.
- •Advisors have updated the financial models which will be used during the RFP phase to measure proposals to determine best value for money for the State. The financial models account for a range of operational costs such as stadium operations, facilities management, and lifecycle costs as well as projected revenues from stadium operations and lease agreements from the ancillary development, as projected in a recent market study.

3. Schedule of Key Work-Streams

Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement (PEIS)

•The draft PEIS is scheduled to be published before the end of the year. This is a slight delay over earlier projections due to extended internal review. This published draft PEIS will commence a 45-day review period.

Request for Qualifications (RFQ)

• The announcement of the priority listed respondents is forthcoming pending decisions related to project governance.

Request for Proposals (RFP)

- •The RFP document is in drafting and the schedule for the release of the RFP is under review.
- •The focus is currently on translating the design principles of the master plan and stadium concept into technical requirements. Subject matter workgroups have been established to facilitate this process.

Master Planning

- •The NASED Programmatic Master Plan (PMP) and Conceptual Master Plan (CMP) documents are both undergoing internal review and nearing completion.
- •The CMP will accompany the Request for Proposals (RFP) and provides a mostly visual representation of the vision of NASED which fits within the technical parameters set forth in the RFP.
