MONTHLY SECURITY REPORT TO THE BOARD

Summary of security related incidents which occurred April 1, 2023, through April 30, 2023.

Harassment

On April 2, 2023, at approximately 10:30 a.m., Swap Meet Vendor was upset with a customer who was asking questions & trying items for a long time, then stated they would return later to purchase. Vendor was grumbling and hit customer with an open hand twice. Honolulu Police Department (HPD) was called and HPD Report was made. Centerplate Security issued a Written Citation to Vendor.

Swap Meet

Four Medical Assistance Calls were reported; one case was Injured Cared For (ICF). Injured person lost their footing while shopping and fell. Stadium Maintenance worker transported injured person in golf cart to North First Aid Station. Injured person was evaluated and treated by Stadium Nurse, then released to family member.

Three cases were Sick Cared For (SCF). In one case, shopper was unsteady while walking and bystanders called Security. Stadium Nurse responded and evaluated and treated person feeling sick until Emergency Medical Services (EMS) arrived. After discussion with Nurse and EMS, patient was transported by EMS Ambulance to Emergency Room. In one case, shopper vomited, then collapsed, after eating. Shopper had a viral illness in days prior to this incident. Stadium Nurse responded and evaluated and treated person feeling sick until EMS arrived. After evaluation by EMS and Nurse, person feeling sick was transported by EMS ambulance to Emergency Room. In one case, shopper and laid shopper on ground. Person feeling sick was evaluated and treated by Stadium Nurse and EMS, then transported via EMS ambulance to Emergency Room.
