Stadium Board Meeting Marketing Update – AUGUST 2023

Marketing and communication efforts will continue to ensure the Aloha Stadium is properly up to date on activities and developments as we move towards a new facility. In addition, we continue to focus on the following items as we continue to host and promote events with the current Stadium:

1. Communications/Marketing/Advertising Coordination

- Stadium event related media coordination as needed.
- Communication coordination with all Hawaii media platforms as they arise.
- Assist clients/sponsors with marketing and communication needs upon request.

2. Update and maintain website

- Continue to maintain and update the website with current events and information on a daily base.
- Continue to update backend site improvement issues online.

3. Social media and ongoing public relations efforts

- Continue to monitor and update daily.

4. New Event Support

- Work in collaboration with the Events team to expand, create and coordinate new programs and activities.

5. Advertising Coordination

- Oversee, as needed, events and activities.
- Oversee and expand sponsorship opportunities and online platforms utilizing new programs as they arise.

6. Swap Meet & Marketplace Coordination

- Continue to review and update swap meet marketing and operational needs
- Coordinate and assist with expanding activities and programs within the swap meet & marketplace including all specialty events within the marketplace.
- Assist with marketing/PR, social media efforts and coordination.

7. Rail Marketing Opportunities and Communication

- Coordinate and assist DTS with onsite events, activities, advertising, media communication.

MONTHLY SECURITY REPORT TO THE BOARD

Brief summary of security related incidents which occurred July 1, 2023, through July 31, 2023.

Burglary at CDL Lot

On July 2, 2023, old Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Trailer, currently being rented by Kiewit Pacific, was Burglarized.

I spoke with Robert from Kiewit Pacific concerning Burglary and stolen vehicles. The suspects were professional burglars, not teenagers.

At approximately 3:00 a.m., Sunday morning, July 2, 2023, unknown suspects cut perimeter fence to Old CDL Trailer in at least two locations. One location Suspects cut the fence was on Mauka-side of trailer, hidden from view by a Kiewit van (which was later stolen).

Once inside perimeter fence, suspects cut padlock for metal bar across Main Entry

Door. Suspects then forced open the regular lock on Front Door, most likely with a crowbar. Suspects then forced open a Deadbolt Lock, possibly using two crow-bars and a sledge hammer.

Once inside trailer, suspects took the hard drive for Security Camera System around the trailer (No security camera footage available). Suspects took computers, work tools and other electronic equipment from inside the Trailer.

Inside trailer, Suspects also found keys for Kiewit truck and van, which were both parked outside. While stealing the Kiewit truck and van, suspects cut the GPS systems for each vehicle, making them harder to track. Kiewit did find the missing truck- it was parked near housing area around Pearl Kai shopping area.

Suspects also broke into metal Conex container next to perimeter fence, stealing work tools and electronic equipment.

Kiewit Pacific did call Honolulu Police Department (HPD) and HPD Reports were filed for 1) Theft of Truck, 2) Theft of Van, 3) Break-In of Conex Container and 4) Break-In of Trailer.

TMR Birthday Bash Concert

On July 29, 2023, one Sick Cared For (SCF) case. Emergency 911 Dispatch contacted Stadium Security and stated an Ambulance and Honolulu Fire Department (HFD) was responding to a Medical Emergency call at Stadium. After checking Concert area, and finding no one with a Medical Emergency, an intoxicated individual was found laying in Upper Halawa Parking Lot roadway, near Pole 6. HFD Engine and EMS Ambulance were escorted to Pole 6. Paramedics from HFD and EMS evaluated & treated person feeling sick. Person feeling sick was transported via ambulance to Emergency Room.

Trespass from Swap Meet

On July 30, 2023, one person was Trespassed from Swap Meet by Centerplate. Person was trying to enter Swap Meet to sell two puppies. Both Stadium Security and Centerplate Staff have had previous contact with this person. Person refuses to provide their name but, Stadium Security and Centerplate have pictures of this person, from previous incidents. Person was issued a Verbal Trespass Warning (stay away for one year) on July 16, 2022, for trying to sell puppies at Swap Meet. Pictures were taken in 2022 and a Trespass Warning was written, which person refused to sign. Centerplate wrote a new Trespass Warning and person refused to take it. Centerplate issued another Verbal warning and took new pictures.

Swap Meet

Stadium Nurses reported two Medical Assistance Call; one case was Injured Cared For (ICF). Injured person lost their balance and feel on both knees and hands. Injured person had abrasions on both palms and bit their bottom lip. Injured person was evaluated and treated by Stadium Nurse, then released to family member. Family member would watch over injured person and would transport to Emergency Room, if needed.

One case was Sick Cared For (SCF). Person feeling sick was visiting a Vendor, who noticed person was dizzy & light-headed. Person feeling sick was evaluated & treated by Stadium Nurse. After drinking water and sitting for a while, person feeling sick felt better and was released on their own.
