MONTHLY SECURITY REPORT TO THE BOARD

Summary of security related incidents which occurred October 1, 2023, through October 31, 2023.

Fight; Trespass Warnings (5 individuals)

On October 1, 2023, at approximately 8:32 a.m., 5 individuals were involved in a fight. Started with an argument between two different Tent Vendors; eventually three individuals from one Tent Vendor and two individuals from a second Tent Vendor were involved. Two groups were separated, and no one wanted to file charges. One individual from each Tent Vendor was issued a Trespass Warning on scene. Other three individuals were called in and were issued Trespass Warnings on October 9, 2023. Trespass Warnings were issued by Stadium Authority and by Centerplate

Criminal Property Damage

On October 1, 2023, at approximately 08:35 a.m., two vehicles were scratched by individuals involved in the fight mentioned above. Both vehicles were owned by Swap Meet Vendors. Honolulu Police Department (HPD) was called and an HPD Report was filed. HPD advised both vehicle owners to contact their respective Insurance Companies.

Attempted Theft; Trespass Warning

On October 8, 2023, at approximately 12:56 p.m., a juvenile male was caught trying to steal bags and boxes of shirts. Two other juvenile males got away. HPD Responded and an HPD Report was filed. Juvenile Male was issued a Trespass Warning by Centerplate.

Open Exit Door

On October 13, 2023, at approximately 5:30 p.m., Allied Universal Security (AUS) and Stadium Security, found an open Exit Door at Turnstile Gate 7. Stadium Security closed and locked Exit Door, and both Security Officers conducted a check of interior of Stadium. No individuals were found in the interior of Stadium, and nothing appeared out of place.

Illegal Entry

On October 13, 2023, at approximately 8:00 p.m., Allied Universal Security (AUS) found an unknown female inside of Stadium, near North Plaza. AUS questioned individual and escorted female outside to Parking Lot. Female walked away, towards Kamehameha Highway. AUS checked interior of Stadium and found no other individuals.

At approximately 8:30 p.m., AUS noticed same female in Parking Lot on Mauka side of Turnstile Gate 8. AUS and Stadium Staff followed female to Kalaloa Gate, where female exited to sidewalk along Salt Lake Boulevard.

At approximately 11:30 p.m., AUS noticed same female on Circle Road, near North Kam Gate. As AUS approached female, she hopped over perimeter fence and exited to sidewalk along Kamehameha Highway.

Criminal Property Damage

On October 28, 2023, at approximately 5:30 p.m., Allied Universal Security (AUS) found perimeter fence cut along H-1 East On-Ramp. Fence was cut approximately 30 feet past "Cattle **G**

Gates" at entrance to On-Ramp. On other side of perimeter fence is Stadium "Dirt Lot". Stadium Maintenance was notified of cut in perimeter fence.

Swap Meet

Seven Medical Assistance Calls were reported; four cases were Injured Cared For (ICF) and three cases were Sick Cared For (SCF). For ICF, two cases happened at same incident. A lady was pushing her elderly mother in a walker, when her mother fell backwards and hit the back of her head on pavement. The lady fell and scraped both of her knees when she tried to catch her mother. Stadium Nurse and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) evaluated and treated both ladies. Two ladies declined EMS transport to hospital. Ladies were able to leave the Stadium on their own. One ICF case, injured person fell over curb in parking lot and hit their head on pavement. Stadium Nurse evaluated and treated injured person and recommended EMS be called for further evaluation and possible transport. EMS arrived and after further evaluation and treatment, the injured person was transported via ambulance to the Emergency Room. One ICF case, injured person was found on sidewalk, outside of Main Entrance. Stadium Nurse provided initial evaluation and treatment of injured person. EMS arrived and after further evaluation and treatment, the injured person was transported via ambulance to the Emergency Room.

For Sick Cared For (SCF), one case person felt faint, dizzy and had stomach pain. Stadium Nurse evaluated and treated person feeling sick, who refused further evaluation by EMS. The person feeling sick was released to their family, who agreed to monitor the person feeling sick and to drive them home. One SCF case, a Centerplate employee walked into North First Aid Station and was evaluated and treated by Stadium Nurse. Stadium Nurse contacted Centerplate Supervisor, who agreed to drive employee to Medical Center. One SCF case, a Stadium Parking employee told their Supervisor they were not feeling well and was preparing to go home. The employee fainted and was caught by another Stadium Parking employee. Honolulu Police Department (HPD) Officer was nearby, along with an Off-Duty Nurse, and both provided aide until Stadium Nurse arrived. After evaluation and treatment by Stadium Nurse, Stadium employee was released to their family member, who agreed to monitor employee and drive them home.
