Summary of security related incidents which occurred November 1, 2023, through November 30, 2023.

# Traffic Incident; Assault

On November 19, 2023, at approximately 11:07 a.m., a Shopper was backing out of parking stall and nearly hit a Food Vendor and their equipment. Food Vendor tapped on Shopper's vehicle to get their attention. Shopper got out of their vehicle and started yelling and threatening Food Vendor. One of Food Vendor's employee heard yelling & threats and came over to assist their Boss. Food Vendor's employee swung at Shopper, who was able to dodge employee's punch. Employee and Shopper were quickly separated, and no injuries were observed or reported. Honolulu Police Department (HPD) was called and an HPD Report was filed. Centerplate issued a Trespass Notice to Food Vendor's Employee

# Motor Vehicle Collision- Major B; Injured Cared For

On November 8, 2023, at approximately 12:25 p.m., it appeared a Shopper driving in Parking Lot bumped into another Shopper, who was walking. First Shopper was driving in between Rows, looking for Swap Meet Vendor they had previously ordered products from, on a different day. Swap Meet Vendor was in a different location on this day.

While making a turn into Row, First Shopper's vehicle appeared to bump Second Shopper, who was walking in Crosswalk. Second Shopper was found sitting on ground, with injury to one foot and scrape to one knee. Stadium Nurse arrived and evaluated & treated Second Shopper. HPD was called, along with Emergency Medical Services (EMS). EMS Supervisor arrived and evaluated & treated Second Shopper. EMS Supervisor cancelled Ambulance, after it had arrived On Scene. HPD Report was filed. Second Shopper felt better and was released on their own, to continue shopping. First Shopper was released by HPD, after all information was gathered. Second Shopper was later observed walking towards Bus Stop on Kamehameha Highway.

# Motor Vehicle Collision- Minor

On November 29, 2023, at approximately 07:00 a.m., at Main Salt Lake Gate Parking Entrance, Vehicle One collided with Vehicle Two, while trying to change lanes. Vehicle One suffered no damage and Vehicle Two had minor damage to front fender. No injuries were observed or stated by both drivers. HPD was called and an HPD Report was filed.

## Property Damage

On November 12, 2023, at approximately 1:30 p.m., a tent was blown by wind and hit a vehicle in next Swap Meet Vendor's Stall. Tent was being taken down by Dan's Fast Tent employee and first Swap Meet Vendor had already left. No Citation was Issued for blown tent. Minor damage to Second Swap Meet Vendor's vehicle. HPD was called and an HPD Report was filed.

# Tents Blown by Wind

On November 5, 2023, at approximately 1:05 p.m., two tents in Section 4D were blown by wind. First Swap Meet Vendor report no injuries. Second Swap Meet Vendor's child was slightly injured by Tent. Second Vendor declined medical services from Aloha Stadium Nurse. Both Swap Meet Vendor's were issued Citations for not securing their respective tents.

# Criminal Property Damage

On November 12, 2023, at approximately 3:30 p.m., Centerplate Security noticed a group of 6-7 juveniles walking on North Plaza. One of juveniles handed a can of spray paint to Centerplate Security but, did not mention why they had can of paint or where they got can of paint. Centerplate Security observed juveniles heading to Parking Lot. Centerplate Security notified Aloha Stadium General Services Supervisor of incident. It was later noted that there was a spot of black paint on Vomitory Wall, near area that Centerplate Security first observed group of juveniles walking on North Plaza.

# **Injury Reported**

On November 12, 2023, at approximately 1:30 p.m., a person called Centerplate Office and stated they had suffered an injury that morning, at about 9:00 a.m. The trip & fall incident happened in Parking Lot, near Main Exit on Salt Lake Boulevard. Person stated that after getting out of their friend's vehicle, they had tripped over a speed bump. While falling, person landed on a gravel bump/curb and injured their knee and scraped their nose. Person noticed a piece of gravel stuck in their knee, so immediately got back in their friend's vehicle and went to Emergency Room. Person and their friend did not notify anyone from Aloha Stadium or Centerplate concerning Incident and injuries, before they drove away. Thus, phone call at 1:30 p.m. Person was referred by Centerplate to State of Hawaii Risk Management Office.

# Swap Meet

One Medical Assistance Call was reported; case was Injured Cared For (ICF). A Daily Vendor was not feeling well and according to Vendors nearby, Daily Vendor passed out and fell face first on ground. Nearby Vendors assisted Daily Vendor, who had scraped their knee and had cuts on their face. Stadium Nurse, Emergency Medical Services (EMS) & Honolulu Fire Department (HFD) responded and evaluated & treated Daily Vendor. Daily Vendor refused EMS transport and returned to work. Daily Vendor was encouraged to hydrate and if they felt dizzy again, to seek medical services.

# Transit Oriented Development Update Franz Kraintz Reported 11.28.23 for 12.14.23 meeting

The CCHNL Zoning Committee met today (November 28, 2023) during a special session and reported out for passage on 3rd reading of both Bills 50 and 51. Bill 50 deals with expanding the TOD Special District to include the area in the Halawa Area TOD Plan and Bill 51 changes the zoning within this area situated at Halawa.

The CD2 version of Bill 50 includes the addition of language to the TOD Special District requirements that will provide for preservation and protection of Native Hawaiian cultural resources, which, in the case of the Pearl Harbor shoreline at Halawa are primarily, the former fishponds found there.

The CD2 version of Bill 51 heard at the special meeting considered and forwarded an amendment of the proposed BMX-3 zoning of Halawa Stream crossing through the stadium property to a P-2 General Preservation zoning designation to preserve it as a 'green corridor'. Where the stream is not defined by a parcel, the P-2 District along that portion of the stream shall be interpreted to extend 50 feet from each side of the channel centerline.

Both Bills in their latest version will be read for the third time for passage by the full Council next Wednesday, December 6, 2023, starting at 10 am. The outcome of the Council meeting will be available in time for the next Stadium Authority Board meeting on December 14, 2023.
