## MONTHLY SECURITY REPORT TO THE BOARD

Stadium Nurse evaluated & treated individual, who was released to return to work. Centerplate Supervisor was advised of injured Employee.

Nurse called EMS, who responded and evaluated & treated individual not feeling well. EMS transported individual to Emergency Room. One case, individual was not feeling well after eating at Stadium. Individual was evaluated & treated by Stadium Nurse. Individual declined further medical treatment. Individual was released to family, who were advised to contact Stadium Nurse, if individual experienced any more medical issues.
