MONTHLY SECURITY REPORT TO THE BOARD

Summary of security related incidents which occurred March 1, 2024, through March 31, 2024.

Assault in Third Degree

On March 10, 2024, a Swap Meet Vendor was assaulted by a unknown Polynesian female. Swap Meet Vendor had yelled at some children, who kept touching items in their Vendor Stall. Unknown female got into an argument with Vendor, then female hit Vendor. Vendor had no visible injuries. Honolulu Police Department (HPD) was called and an HPD Report was filed. Unknown female suspect left the area before Sodexo Live and Allied Universal Security arrived.

<u>Theft</u>

On March 10, 2024, three unknown male juveniles took three items from a Swap Meet Vendor stall. While running away from Vendor stall, unknown juveniles dropped two of three items stolen. Swap Meet Vendor declined to file an HPD Report. Swap Meet Report filed, with descriptions of three unknown juvenile males.

Attempted Theft/Harassment

On March 17, 2024, two unknown juvenile males attempted to steal a box of designer handbags. Juveniles were scared away by Swap Meet Vendor. When Sodexo Live Staff arrived at scene, two unknown males were in the area. Two juvenile males yelled profanity at Sodexo Live Staff and made threatening gestures. Two juvenile males left Stadium property when Sodexo Live Staff tried to approach them. Swap Meet Report was filed, with descriptions of two unknown juvenile males.

Motor Vehicle Collision (MVC)- Minor

On March 16, 2024, Swap Meet Vendor was trying to park their truck, when they hit a truck belonging to a different Swap Meet Vendor. HPD was called and HPD Report was filed.

Swap Meet

Seven Medical Assistance calls were reported. Five calls were Injured Cared For (ICF); three ICFs were Trip & Fall.

- 1. Swap Meet Vendor was walking towards Restrooms during early morning setup and Tripped and Fell in parking lot Vendor area. Emergency Medical Services (EMS) was called because Stadium Nurse was not On-Duty. Swap Meet Vendor was evaluated and provided medical aid by EMS, then released to return to their Swap Meet Stall.
- 2. Swap Meet customer tripped over a curb in parking lot. Customer was evaluated and provided medical aid by Stadium Nurse. Customer was released to continue shopping.
- 3. Swap Meet customer tripped and fell on sidewalk along Salt Lake Boulevard, after getting off The Bus. Stadium Nurse evaluated and provided medical aid to the customer. Stadium Nurse recommended calling EMS, who arrived and provided further evaluation and treatment. EMS decided to transport the customer to the Emergency Room, via EMS ambulance.

Swap Meet (continued)

- 4. Swap Meet customer was hit by a pole used to hold up Vendor's tarp, which had been lifted by strong winds. After being knocked to the ground, the customer was hit a second time by the same pole. Other customers moved the injured customer and Stadium Nurse was brought to scene of incident. Stadium Nurse evaluated and provided medical aid to the customer, who was released to continue shopping with their friends.
- 5. Swap Meet customer was at Vendor Stall and fell when they stepped backwards. Injured Customer was helped by other unknown customers, who cleaned and bandaged injured customer's abrasions. Injured Customer refused evaluation by Stadium Nurse and declined calling Emergency Medical Services (EMS) when Allied Universal Security (AUS) and Stadium Nurse arrived at scene. Injured Customer continued shopping.

Two Medical Assistance calls were for Sick Cared For (SCF).

- Allied Universal Security (AUS) noticed a Swap Meet customer in "Closed" Section of North Plaza. When AUS approached customer, customer appeared confused and lost. AUS asked the customer if they needed medical assistance but, customer refused evaluation by Stadium Nurse. Customer signed Swap Meet Report Form, declining medical evaluation. AUS transported customer to their vehicle and customer stated they were okay to drive home.
- Swap Meet Vendor felt dizzy and complained of a slight headache. Vendor was evaluated by Stadium Nurse, who provided medical aid. After reevaluation by Stadium Nurse, Swap Meet Vendor stated they felt better and wanted to return to their Vendor Stall. Swap Meet Vendor was released by Stadium Nurse.
