- E-Commerce online and Oahu Auctions coordination.

CHRIS J. SADAYASU STADIUM DEPUTY MANAGER Summary of security related incidents which occurred May 1, 2024, through May 31, 2024.

## Auto Theft during Concert

On May 11, 2024, during Concert in Upper Halawa Parking Lot, a customer reported their vehicle had been stolen. Customer had checked all Sections near their parking stall, in Section 12C. Honolulu Police Department (HPD) was called and an HPD Report was filed.

## Argument & Terroristic Threatening during Concert

On May 12, 2024, during Concert in Upper Halawa Parking Lot, a Stadium Parking employee reported an argument and Terroristic Threatening at Uber/Lyft Pick-Up area. An unidentified person was speeding past Uber/Lyft pick-up area and people waiting in area yelled at Driver of speeding vehicle. Driver stopped, got out of their vehicle and yelled at people waiting. Driver then threatened to get a gun and shoot people waiting. Driver returned to their vehicle and argued with a passenger in vehicle. Allied Universal Security (AUS) assigned as Parking Lot Rovers arrived at Uber/Lyft area and Driver got back in their vehicle & drove away. AUS checked with people waiting in Uber/Lyft area and no one could provide a License number of vehicle or positively identify Driver who had been arguing with them. AUS asked if anyone in waiting area had any injuries or wanted to file a Police Report- all persons involved responded, "No". Stadium Security and Honolulu Police Department (HPD) Officers arrived on Scene, but Driver and vehicle had already departed. The people who had been involved in argument with Driver had also already departed area. No HPD Report was filed for this incident.

## <u>Theft</u>

On May 5, 2024, a Swap Meet Vendor reported that someone, possibly a customer, had taken Vendor's backpack. Vendor's backpack contained their wallet, credit cards, Driver's license and key inside, along with miscellaneous items. Swap Meet Vendor stated they had been distracted because a customer's credit card kept being "Declined," and after customer left with no purchase, Vendor realized their backpack was missing. Swap Meet Vendor filed an HPD Report.

## Lost Wallet

On May 12, 2024, a Swap Meet customer reported that when they reached in their purse, they realized purse's zipper was "open" and their wallet was missing. Their wallet contained their credit cards, Driver's License and cash. Customer stated they were had been shopping between Sections 11 to 14. Honolulu Police Department was called and an HPD Report was filed.

## Missing Person, Found

On May 26, 2024, a Swap Meet customer reported their 80-year-old family member, who has Dementia, was missing. Approximately 30 minutes later, someone contacted Sodexo Live Staff

member and reported they had found an 80-year-old person. Customer was re-united with their elderly family member.

## Miscellaneous Public

On May 25, 2024, Swap Meet Manager had an alleged theft; after hearing all sides of story, it was a misunderstanding. On May 22, 2024, a Swap Meet Vendor hired Tent Vendor 1 (TV1) to set up tarp & poles for their Vendor stall. After set-up, Swap Meet Vendor decided they no longer wanted to use TV1. Vendor texted TV1 and said Vendor would pay for tarp and TV1 could come get TV1's poles. Vendor did not get a response from TV1.

On May 25, 2024, Swap Meet Vendor hired Tent Vendor 2 (TV2) to set-up Vendor's tarp, along with TV2's poles. TV2 placed tarp and poles in Swap Meet Vendor's Stall, for TV2's crew to set-up. One of TV1's workers drove by and saw Swap Meet Vendor's Tarp and realized it was TV1's tarp that was missing at end of Day, May 22<sup>nd</sup>. TV1's worker took Swap Meet Vendor's tarp and drove away.

When TV2's crew arrived, Swap Meet Vendor's tarp was missing. TV2 called the Swap Meet Vendor, who called Swap Meet Office. Swap Meet Manager met with Swap Meet Vendor and TV2, then called TV1. TV1 stated they did receive a text message from Swap Meet Vendor on May 22<sup>nd</sup> but, did not reply.

Swap Meet Vendor agreed to pay TV1 for tarp Swap Meet Vendor took on May 22nd. Swap Meet Vendor was Cited for taking TV1's Tarp on May 22<sup>nd</sup>, without authorization or agreement from TV1.

TV1 was Cited because their worker took Swap Meet Vendor's tarp from Vendor's stall, without authorization from Swap Meet Vendor.

No Honolulu Police Department Report was filed for this incident.

## Medical Assistance during Concerts

On May 10, 2024, inside Concert area, Honolulu Police Department (HPD) Officers contacted Stadium Security and requested medical assistance. Stadium Security contacted Medics hired for Concert area. A person attending Concert was not feeling well and asked Medics to call an ambulance. Person not feeling well told Medics they had a pre-existing medical condition, which was flaring up. HPD Officers on Scene called for an ambulance. While waiting for ambulance, Medics continued to provide medical aid to person not feeling well. Person not feeling well eventually felt better and Medics stated person was now stable. Person not feeling well, along with Medics, asked HPD Officers to cancel ambulance. HPD Officers cancelled ambulance response and person who was now stable, was released to their friends, who agreed to monitor their friend's medical condition.

On May 11, 2024, during Concert in Upper Halawa Parking Lot, Allied Universal Security (AUS) was assigned to Parking Lot Rover. AUS called Stadium Security to assist with a person not feeling well. Stadium Security met with AUS & person not feeling well, who asked Stadium Security to call for an ambulance, because of their pre-existing medical condition. City & County Emergency Medical Services (EMS) ambulance arrived on Scene. City & County EMS personnel evaluated & provided medical assistance to person not feeling well. City & County

Emergency Medical Services (EMS) ambulance transported person not feeling well to Emergency Room.

### Medical Assistance during Swap Meet

Stadium Nurses reported Four Medical Assistance calls during May 2024. Two calls were Injured Cared For (ICF); both ICFs were Trip & Fall. One case, a customer tripped & fell over a curb in Upper Halawa Parking Lot. Customer was rushing because a second car was parking in next stall. Customer & family were walking near Section 14D and flagged down a Stadium Maintenance employee. Stadium Employee contacted Stadium Security, who met injured person and their family at 14D. Stadium Security transported injured person and family to North First Aid Station. Stadium Nurse evaluated and proved medical aid to injured person. Injured person and family decided to leave, after medical aid was provided. Stadium Security transported injured person and family back to their vehicle. Second case, customer was returning to their car after shopping and tripped & fell in Section 1D. Stadium Nurse and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) evaluated & provided medical aid. Injured person's family member arrived at scene. Injured person was released to their family member, who transported injured person to Emergency Room.

Two cases were Sick Cared For (SCF). A concerned customer called Stadium Administration Office to report another customer not feeling well. Stadium Administration Office contacted Stadium Security, who met person feeling sick in Section 9B. Concerned customer, who had called Administration Office, had continued to provide assistance to person not feeling well. Second Stadium Security Officer brought Stadium Nurse to Section 9B. Stadium Nurse evaluated and provided medical aid to person not feeling well. A Friend of person not feeling well, stated they had finished shopping and were walking back to their car. After Stadium Nurse released person not feeling well, Stadium Security transported person not feeling well and their friend to their vehicle. Second case, a Swap Meet customer was not feeling well and customer's family member called for an Ambulance. City & County of Honolulu, Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel arrived via ambulance. Ambulance EMS personnel evaluated & provided medical assistance to person not feeling well. Customer's family member stated person not feeling well may have taken a double dose of their morning medication, by mistake. City & County ambulance transported person not feeling well to Emergency Room.
