Stadium Board Meeting Marketing Update – AUGUST 2024

Marketing and communication efforts will continue to ensure the Aloha Stadium is properly up to date on activities and developments as we move towards a new facility. In addition, we continue to focus on the following items as we continue to host and promote events with the current Stadium:

1. Communications/Marketing/Advertising Coordination

- Stadium event related media coordination as needed.
- Communication coordination with all Hawaii media platforms as they arise.
- Assist clients/sponsors with marketing and communication needs upon request.

2. Update and maintain website

- Continue to maintain and update the website with current events and information on a daily base.
- Continue to update backend site improvement issues online.

3. Social media and ongoing public relations efforts

- Continue to monitor and update daily with new content across all media platforms.
- Create monthly media content calendar.

4. New Event Support

- Work in collaboration with the Events team to expand, create and coordinate new programs and activities.

5. Advertising Coordination

- Oversee, as needed, events and activities.
- Oversee and expand sponsorship opportunities and online platforms utilizing new programs as they arise.
- Oversee Swap Meet & Marketplace monthly advertising reports and promotions.

6. Swap Meet & Marketplace Coordination

- Continue to review and update swap meet marketing and operational needs, advertising report reconciliations.
- Coordinate and assist with expanding activities including the 45th Anniversary Celebration along with programs within the swap meet & marketplace including all specialty events within the marketplace.
- Assist with marketing/PR, social media efforts and coordination.

7. Swap Meet & Marketplace Relocation

- Assist with future swap meet operations and market layout.
- Assist with vendor communications on market plans and layout.
- Coordinate new retail opportunities.

8. Miscellaneous

- Assist with NASED PR campaigns, media, neighborhood board meetings, e-newsletter content, and operational coordination for new stadium (NASED) as needed.

9. Auction and Online E-commerce

- Coordinate inventory relocation and documentation of sports museum items as they arise.

juvenile males running down North Kam Gate Ramp, toward Rail Station. Swap Meet Vendor declined to file a Honolulu Police Department (HPD) Report.

Motor Vehicle Collision

On July 14, 2024, report of Motor Vehicle Collision in Upper Halawa Parking Lot (UHPL). A Swap Meet customer parked their vehicle up against a Storage Container, which had been placed in UHPL, for use by Concert Promotor on July 12th and 13th. Owner of Container called Stadium Security and requested a Honolulu Police Department (HPD) Report. Owner of Container waited for owner of vehicle to return to their vehicle. When vehicle was reversed, there was no visible damage to vehicle or Container. HPD Report was filed and both parties left UHPL.

Criminal Property Damage (CPD)

On July 28, 2024, Swap Meet Vendor reported their vehicle had been scratched when Tent Vendor was installing Swap Meet Tarp. Swap Meet Vendor's vehicle was already parked, when Tent Vendor tried to install Tarp over Vendor's Stall. HPD Report was filed.

On July 31, 2024, a hole in perimeter fence was reported near North Kam Gate. It was determined that a smaller hole in fence (about 1-inch by 1.5-inch) had appeared in fence about eighteen months ago. Hole had been temporarily patched. On July 31st, someone had made hole larger, (about 5-inch by 8-inch). Fence at this location is about 4-feet high. HPD Report was filed for CPD.

Medical Assistance during Swap Meet

Stadium Nurses reported 11 Medical Assistance calls during July 2024.

Three calls were Injured Cared For (ICF); none of ICFs were Trip & Fall.

One case, a customer with a history of leg pain, was experiencing pain in their leg & lost their balance. No significant injury. Stadium Nurse and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) responded. Customer was evaluated, treated and released. Customer refused EMS transport.

One case, customer had an abrasion on top of foot from wearing "flip flops". Customer was evaluated, treated and released by Stadium Nurse. It was suggested customer should wear shoes during extended walking.

One case, Swap Meet Vendor was hit when a Vendor Tent was lifted & blown by a gust of wind. Vendor was knocked down and had abrasions. Vendor was assisted by another Swap Meet Vendor. Injured Vendor declined Stadium Nurse and EMS; stated they would seek medical care on their own. Ⓞ

MONTHLY SECURITY REPORT TO THE BOARD

Summary of Security related incidents which occurred July 1, 2024, through July 31, 2024.

Burglary 2, Auto Theft

On July 22, 2024, it was determined that two Stadium golf carts were stolen on July 21, 2024, between 6:00 p.m., and 12 a.m., midnight. Suspects cut padlocks at Turnstile Iron Gate 6, North Plaza storage area and corner of Salt Lake Boulevard and Kamehameha Highway. It appears suspects had their own bolt cutters. A third Stadium golf cart had a damaged ignition. Honolulu Police Department (HPD) was called and an HPD Report was filed for Burglary 2 and Auto Theft. Both carts were recovered on July 22, 2024; one at Pu'uwai Momi Housing complex and one at Community Park next to Pu'uwai Momi. Third golf cart with damaged ignition was repaired by Stadium Maintenance Staff. Stadium Security replaced three padlocks.

On July 23, 2024, it was determined that three Stadium golf carts and one Sodexo Live golf cart were stolen overnight. Suspects cut padlocks at Turnstile Iron Gate 6, Vomitory R and corner of Salt Lake Boulevard and Kamehameha Highway. It appears suspects had their own bolt cutters. Two Stadium golf carts were recovered on July 23rd, both at Pu'uwai Momi Housing Complex. One golf cart had a broken front-end and Stadium Maintenance Staff used a forklift to bring cart back. This golf cart will be used for parts, to repair our other golf carts. HPD Report was filed for Burglary. Sodexo Live filed an HPD Report for their stolen golf cart. Stadium Security replaced all three padlocks.

On July 24, 2024, Sodexo Live recovered their stolen golf cart.

On July 31, 2024, HPD found third Stadium golf cart near Rainbow Bay, across the street from Pu'uwai Momi Housing Complex. HPD was able to drive stolen golf cart to Rail Station, where AUS Security met HPD and brought Stadium golf cart back to Stadium Security Office.

Forgery

On July 27, 2024, it was determined a counterfeit \$20 bill had been used at Swap Meet Cashier. Cashier who accepted \$20 bill stated they checked bill with "Counterfeit" Pen and it came back "okay." When Cashier went to turn in their Cash Drawer at end of Shift, the Counting machine rejected one \$20 bill as counterfeit. Cashier could not remember who used fake \$20 bill because it was a busy day and Fraud Pen did not flag fake bill. HPD Report was filed for Forgery.

Theft

On July 28, 2024, a Swap Meet Vendor reported that five juvenile males entered their Vendor tent and were looking around. One male then took a t-shirt and all five males ran in different directions. Vendor gave a description to Sodexo Security, who followed suspects and last saw 8

Eight cases were Sick Cared For (SCF).

One case, worker at Food Vendor was dizzy & nausea. Stadium Nurse evaluated, treated & released to return to work. Worker's Supervisor was advised to monitor worker for return of symptoms and to seek medical care, if needed.

One case, customer had an insect bite or sting. Customer evaluated, treated and released by Stadium Nurse to their family members

One case, customer was dizzy & vomiting. Customer evaluated, treated and released by Stadium Nurse to their family members. Security transported customer to their vehicle.

One case, customer with history of low blood pressure, asked for their vital signs to be checked by Stadium Nurse. Stadium Nurse took Customer's vital signs, which were all normal and stable. Customer was released on their own. Stadium Security transported customer to their vehicle.

One case, Sodexo Live employee was feeling dizzy & body aches. Stadium Nurse evaluated, treated & released to Sodexo Live Supervisor. Supervisor & Employee were advised to have employee go home to rest. Employee was also advised to follow-up with their personal Doctor.


One case, customer was dizzy and was advised to sit & rest. Customer declined call to Stadium Nurse & signed the Release.

One case, customer experienced a seizure. Family members with customer stated customer had a history of seizures and they had customer's seizure medicine. Family members declined call to Stadium Nurse or EMS.

One case, customer felt dizzy & faint. Customer's family member caught customer when they fainted. Customer did not hit their head and suffered no injuries. Stadium Nurse, Honolulu Fire Department (HFD) & Emergency Medical Services (EMS) arrived & evaluated, treated and released customer to their family members.
