I. CALL TO ORDER

A quorum being present, Chair Morioka called the meeting to order at 8:01 a.m.

II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- A. Approval of minutes for the following date:
 - 1. Regular Session Meeting February 27, 2025

A MOTION WAS MADE BY MEMBER PEREIRA AND SECONDED BY MEMBER WICKER TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR SESSION. THE MOTION WAS UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED.

III. MONTHLY REPORTS

- A. Interim Stadium Manager's Report and Operational Reports
 - 1. Operational Updates and Announcements
 - a. Swap Meet Relocation
 - MEI Contractors have begun work in the Upper Halawa Lot on waterlines, sewer lines and electrical. Work should be complete mid-June.
 - A vendor meeting was held to provide an update on the upcoming relocation.
 - The move is expected to take place in July.
 - b. Relocation of Stadium Authority offices

The stadium is working with AHDP and Hawaiian Dredging for details on this move during construction.

 Significant Bills and Budget Matters Affecting the Stadium Authority – (Agenda Item III.A.7.)

Highlighting the following the bills we are planning to testify on and/or monitor:

- HB300 (Relating to the State Budget) regarding the ceiling increase request for \$49.5M. This was not concurred by the House Finance Committee and decision making for Ways and Means Committee is next week.
- SB1589 (Relating to the Stadium Development Special Fund) is the bill that provides the ceiling appropriation for the stadium development special fund and is being heard in the House.
- HB1494 (Relating to Sports Facilities) which proposed to lapse the new Halawa stadium appropriation was heard by the Senate Committee on Economic Development and Tourism and was amended to remove the lapsing of the new Halawa stadium appropriation and included language providing the \$49.5M ceiling appropriation for the stadium development special fund.
- SB583 (Relating to Naming Rights). This bill was amended to specifically provide naming rights for the Stadium Facility and the Convention Center.

Chair Morioka stated that the most critical bill being tracked is the bill regarding lifting of the ceiling to have access to the \$49.5M in general funds to push the project forward.

- d. Foodbank Update
 - The Stadium Authority is the lead agency coordinating this year's Foodbank campaign for DBEDT.

- Samantha Spain shared the Foodbank Campaign efforts. (Exhibit B)

February ended the month with a surplus of \$208.2K, a net cash balance of \$56.5M, and a projected carryover cash balance of \$56.9M for FY26. (Exhibit C)

 - We are making progress on the Pre-Development Agreement. The team expects to sign the agreement soon and move into negotiations for the Master Development Agreement and the Project Lease Agreement.
 - Jon Nouchi from DTS stated that he can be available for a presentation for the April board meeting to explain how the next segment of the Skyline will impact the Aloha Stadium.
 - Member Pereira stated that the Honolulu City Council took up Resolution 25-56, which
 creates a Permitted Interaction Group (PIG) to study Tax Increment Financing. He urged
 Jon Nouchi to join the effort since Tax Increment Financing will not only unlock NASED,
 but it can also unlock the full potential of TOD districts along the Skyline.
