# CALL TO ORDER

A quorum being present, Chair Morioka called the meeting to order at 8:01 a.m.

#### II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- A. Approval of minutes for the following date:
  - 1. Regular Session Meeting March 20, 2025

A MOTION WAS MADE BY MEMBER PEREIRA AND SECONDED BY MEMBER TAMAMOTO TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR SESSION. THE MOTION WAS UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED.

### III. MONTHLY REPORTS

- A. Interim Stadium Manager's Report and Operational Reports
  - 1. Operational Updates and Announcements
    - a. Swap Meet Relocation
      - MEI Contractors are working on utility connection and repaving the Upper Halawa Lot.
      - Work should be completed mid-June.
    - b. Significant Bills and Budget Matters Affecting the Stadium Authority (Agenda Item III.A.7.)

Highlighting the following the bills being monitored:

- HB300 (Relating to the State Budget) regarding the ceiling increase request for \$49.5M. This was not included in HB300 D1 and was not agreed upon between the House and Senate.
- SB1589 (Relating to the Stadium Development Special Fund) has not been scheduled for a conference committee hearing.
- HB1494 (Relating to Sports Facilities) has not been scheduled for a conference committee hearing.
- SB583 (Relating to Naming Rights). We are still tracking this bill that was amended to specifically provide naming rights for the Stadium Facility and the Convention Center.
- HB1007 (Relating to Hawaii Community Development) Authorizing HCDA to issue revenue bonds to finance infrastructure in its development districts.
- SB1337 (Relating to Stadium Quorum) Passed, but still subject to conference committee hearing.

Gordon Wood from DAGS made a statement to clarify ownership of the stadium. The stadium will always remain under the State's ownership. The developer will not lease the stadium but will assist the State with operation of the stadium.

2. Monthly Financial Report

March ended the month with a loss of \$51.1K, a net cash balance of \$56.5M, and a projected carryover cash balance of \$56.9M for FY26. (Exhibit B)

  - Effective March 31, 2025 the Pre-Development Agreement was executed with Aloha Halawa District Partners (AHDP).
  - Chair Morioka has been on several media outlets providing updates on the project.

#### Discussion:

Chair Morioka addressed the special fund ceiling with access to the \$49.5M. He stated that the project can still move forward without the ceiling and it will not delay the project, but it will make the financing more complicated and cash payouts will be a little slower.

Member Tamamoto clarified that the \$49.5M has already been appropriated and the ceiling is requesting the use of that appropriation.

Member Thoemmes asked if the developer has provided a cashflow schedule in terms of the draws they need to make.

Chair Morioka responded that there are some drafts and concepts, but they are waiting for finalization of contract terms and documents before they can finalize financing.

Member Pereira asked as AHDP reaches milestones, where the funding comes from tied to the Pre-Development Agreement.

Interim Manager Sadayasu responded that will be paid from the G.O. bonds and therefore there are no restrictions on those funds.

Chair Morioka concluded that this has been a very productive time with AHDP and everyone is motivated to execute the contract by this summer to reach the next milestone.
