I. CALL TO ORDER

A quorum being present, Chair Fujimoto called the meeting to order at 8:01 a.m.

(Michael Yadao entered the meeting at 8:07 a.m.)

II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- A. Approval of minutes for the following date:
 - 1. Regular Session Meeting July 31, 2025

A MOTION WAS MADE BY MEMBER THOEMMES AND SECONDED BY MEMBER PEREIRA TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR SESSION. THE MOTION WAS UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED.

- Chair Fujimoto stated the minutes from the August 13th Special Meeting will be reviewed and up for approval by the board at the September 25th meeting.
- Chair Fujimoto welcomed the newest board member, Joel Kawachi, Moanalua High School Athletic Director.

III. MONTHLY REPORTS

- A. Interim Stadium Manager's Report and Operational Reports
 - 1. Operational Updates and Announcements
 - a. Interim Manager Sadayasu stated this is the first time the Stadium Authority has all nine voting seats filled.
 - b. Swap Meet Relocation
 - Finishing the work on the Upper Halawa Lot to prepare for the move:
 - o Retail units in place and leveled
 - o Shade structures are being installed
 - o Ho'okipa tent in place
 - Plumbing connection for restrooms
 - Temporary electrical upgrades have been made, and additional work will be completed when the contractor receives the long-lead items on order
 - Relocation will take place this Fall.
 - c. Working closely with AHDP and Hawaiian Dredging on the closure of the area around the stadium site as we move forward with the mobilization of the stadium dismantling.
 - 2. Monthly Financial Report

We ended the month with a surplus of \$656.7K, and a net cash balance of \$56.1M. (Exhibit B)

Athletic Director Elliott provided an update.

 Wahine volleyball will begin on Friday, August 29th with a home game against Marquette.

- Women's soccer is playing at the Waipio Soccer Complex.
- The football game against Stanford sold out T.C. Ching field with 2,000 students attending at full capacity. There was tailgating in 200 stalls with pre-game entertainment. The team is headed to Arizona. The remaining games will take place at 6:00 pm.
- 8. New Aloha Stadium Entertainment District (NASED) Committee Report Interim Stadium Manager Sadayasu asked David Harris to provide an update: David Harris:
 - On August 13th the board held a special meeting to authorize the interim stadium manager to execute two agreements: Stadium Development and Operation Agreement and the Initial Ground Lease Agreement. He announced that the documents are complete and finalized and under administrative review to be executed.
 - Through the Department of Planning and Permitting and the City and County of Honolulu, a permit has been issued to commence the demolition process.

Discussion

Member Tamamoto asked if AHDP will take over with security, etc. once demolition begins. Mr. Harris responded that AHDP will install construction dust fencing around the upper area which will be patrolled and secured.

Member Pereira asked what the dismantling of the stadium would look like.

Mr. Harris responded that AHDP will start mobilization activities which include final demolition design elements, install site fencing, moving machinery down to the site and establishing site offices. Next AHDP will start abatement of materials within the stadium site which need to be done before the dismantling can begin. The public will see steel being dismantled early in the new year. The full process should take approximately twelve months.

- 9. Department of Transportation Services Jon Nouchi provided an update:
 - Skyline's second Opening Ceremony is scheduled for Wednesday, October 15th.
 - The public will be able to ride the new segment beginning October 16th.
 - Fare free weekend will be available through the entire transit system on October 18th
 -19th
 - The new opening will bring on four new stations and five miles of track.
 - Services hours will be expanded from 4:00 a.m. − 10:30 p.m. every day.
 - From Lagoon Drive there will be a "U" line which is a one stop bus to UH Manoa which will begin towards the end of the football season.

IV. ANNOUNCEMENTS

Chair Fujimoto stated that the next board meeting is scheduled for Thursday, September 25th at 8:00 a.m. The meeting will continue to be hybrid with video conference and in-person attendance.
